Armando:

In response to your recent letter regarding the advantages of iDocket, I can say I wholeheartedly agree with your observations. We loaded our files onto the Internet site on September 1, 1999 and have realized both subtle and significant benefits. iDocket has reversed the traditional method of delivering court information to the general public. Before iDocket, citizens had to contact our office to inquire about documents on file and other activities within a court case. As you can imagine, we spent a lot of time on the phone each day responding to inquiries.

We have noticed a significant drop in the number of phone calls for information. Once we inform callers that information is available on the Internet, they find it more convenient and accessible. Litigation often moves at a fast and furious pace and the legal community likes the 24/7 access to our database. In past years callers were limited to obtaining information from staff members from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m., and *never* on a weekend or holiday. Now our entire database is available anytime.

It is also most helpful to us to have iDocket available when our system is down. It serves as a temporary back up system that we can use to obtain information for our needs when access to our system is interrupted.

I am impressed with the number of counties that have joined the consortium. They too must see the benefits of using the Internet to improve services. I believe that whether by choice or mandate, clerks will be forced to place court records on the Internet to meet the demand for information. iDocket allows clerks to control the process rather than react to it. Thanks so much for your cooperation and willingness to make iDocket a viable, "clerk friendly" tool that we can use to improve the judicial system.

Judicial Records Online using Ruby

Our fundamental belief is that the court Clerk is the elected custodian of the record. We respect the wish of each Clerk in deciding what data they want to make available on the Internet.

We charge the Clerks' copy fee. Whatever the Clerk asks us to charge, we can accommodate. Most have chosen \$1/page with no limit on document size.

Our database contains all public cases the Clerk has in their CMS. If the Clerk adds old cases to their CMS, we pick them up as well.

We have Criminal, Civil, and Probate cases. Family Law is categorized as a Civil case.

Court settings are displayed with case information.

Attorneys get their (daily) court calendar of cases on the docket for the next five business days.

Users get (daily) notifications on any updates of cases they track.

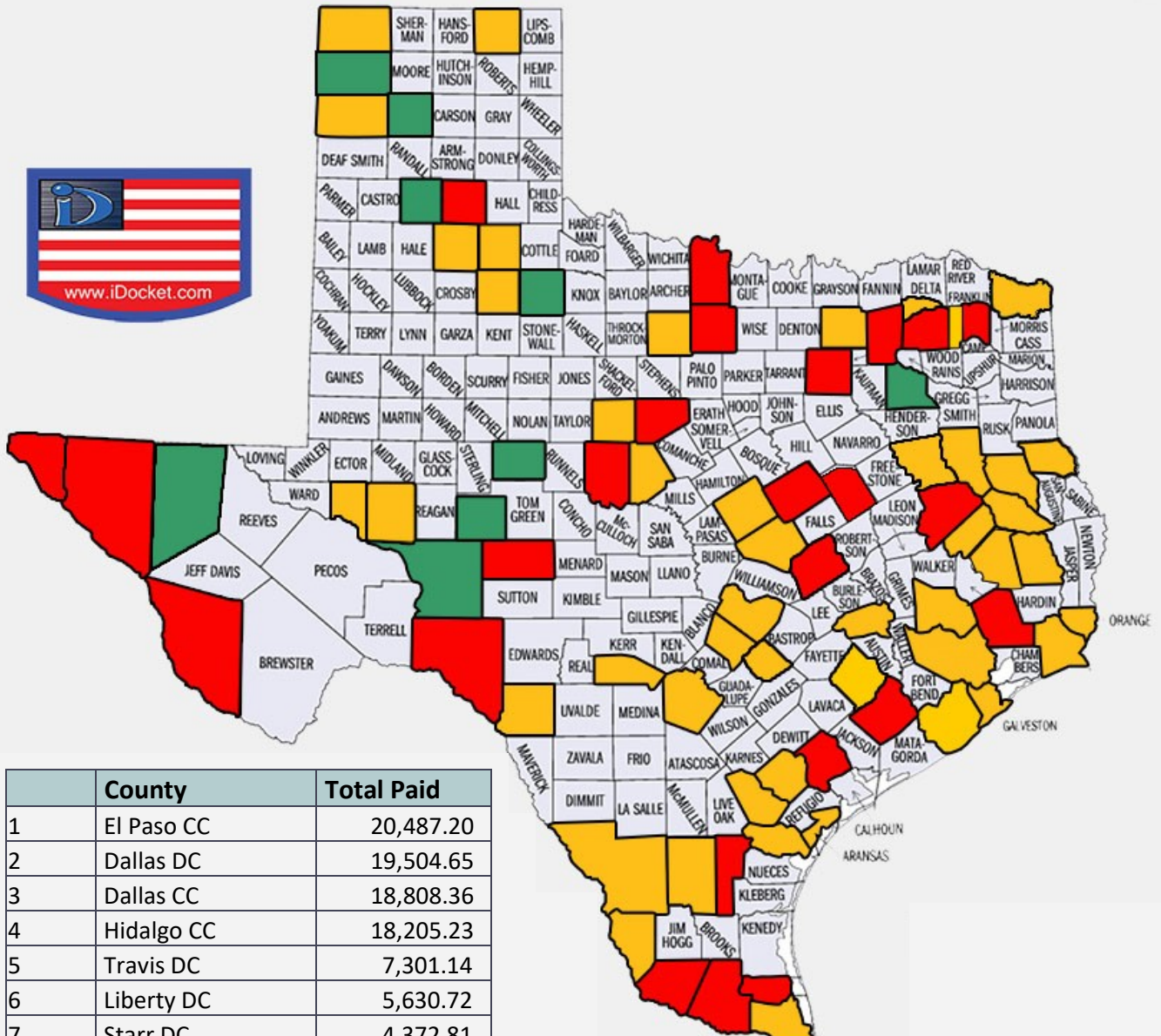
- Less customer traffic and fewer phone calls lead to a more efficient and time-saving clerk's office.

About Cindy Groomer

Cindy Groomer was the District Clerk in Amarillo from 1987 to 2000. It was her vision that inspired the creation of iDocket.com. She designed the concept and flow from the Clerks office updating daily case information making it as current as when the courthouse opens each morning. Most importantly, if and when a case becomes non-public (non-disclosure, expungements) it is removed from our database simply by the Clerks doing their normal work without any extra effort required.

Our gratitude to Cindy Groomer who passed in 2005. Her legacy has been established in Texas as iDocket promotes their web site service world-wide.

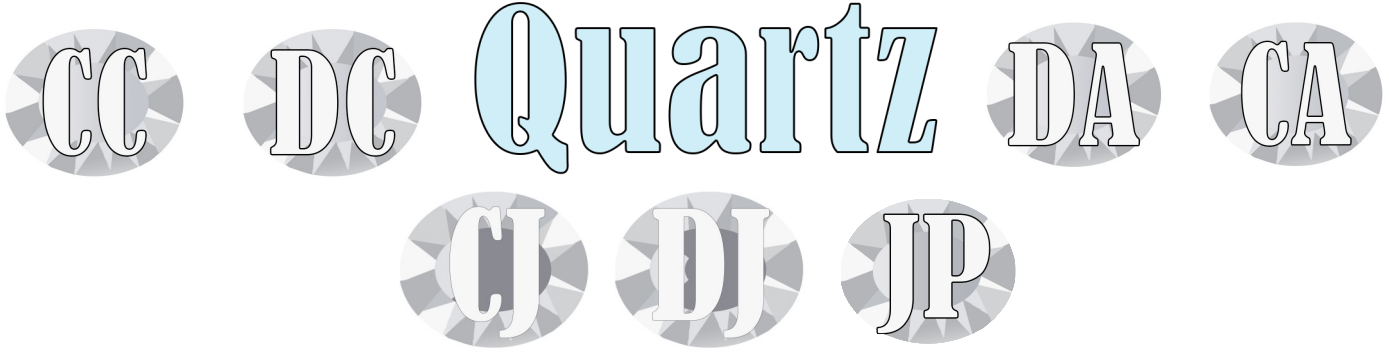
